

## John Lowell Anderson "All That I Know" EP Out 2.19.21

Sometimes, songs fit so perfectly together that they create a whole shimmering world within wavelengths. The interior architecture of John Lowell Anderson's album "All That I Know" matches the exterior in depth, quality and craft. This three-song EP takes the listener on a masterfully-produced journey through the little quakes that dissolve viewpoints, leading us to find stunning new angles from which to gaze upon the world.

"This EP concerns the shifting of beliefs and the relearning that must be done as a result," singer and composer John Lowell Anderson reflects. "Nothing that I was used to is what I see now, what I believe now. The shifting of perspective can be unsettling, but gives way to new creative ground. When your foundation is shaken you see how much you relied upon it, and it changes everything."

"All That I Know" was recorded at Boulevard Recording with producer Tyler Chester (Andrew Bird, Dawes) and engineer/mixer James Krausse, who doubles as Anderson's longtime mentor. It was Anderson's first time working on his music with a producer. "Change can be for the good, especially in collaboration. Welcoming new voices into this project elevated it in a way I couldn't have done alone. Making the EP was reliving the practice of being open to change, and reviving the songs' meanings."
