In the true blue spirit of Tears For Fears and Phil Collins comes Teddy at Night, a project that serves up 80s nostalgia with a modern twist. And who better to do that than Teddy Boldt, who grew up listening to 80s music in sunny Palm Springs. The style was deeply ingrained in Teddy's heart, so much so that it naturally pours out when he composes. Currently living in Nashville, Teddy worked as a touring drummer for international acts for years. Now he's writing, singing and performing as the artist Teddy At Night.

"The 80s culture was such a risky time when people were trying more than they ever had - with art, with drugs, with people. It was such an exciting time to grow and learn and express yourself," Teddy says. The music video for "Blueberry Water" was shot in his neighborhood of East Nashville. Teddy sings in the shower, prowls the empty streets and smashes guitars, all while being his charming, natural self. "I'm hoping that this reckless, Palm Springs 80s mobster vibe translates."

"Blueberry Water" is a song about love and how it bends, breaks, mends and consumes you. "The song refers to the kind of first kiss in which you suddenly see the next 10 years flash before your eyes." In fact, the lyrics "Yeah you taste like\ Blueberry water..." refer to Teddy's wife, who was drinking blueberry vodka and water when they had their first kiss. "Realizing you want to do anything you can to stick around that person kinda makes you feel like you wanna smash a guitar. Brutally honest love is the best kind."
